Review of Previous Minutes

Old Business:

- 1) Parish Council will sponsor the Sunday Donuts on March 7, 2010.
- 2) Evangelization CDs – (Paul Moretz) The Knights of Columbus have provided the funding to start this project. Initially, the CDs were well received and sales equaled the funding provided. As sales of the CDs has slowed, new titled have been ordered and will be available in approximately two weeks. Additionally, the sign that explains the procedure of purchasing the CDs was moved in the hope for better understanding of the process. The titles of the CDs will be changed approximately every six weeks and an announcement will be made periodically by the cantor before Masses.
- 3) Pastoral Social - The event was conducted on Sept. 18, 2009 and was an enjoyable event for all who attended.
- 4) New Parishioner Social – This event was held Nov. 13, 2009 and was more lightly attended this year than in the past. Questions were raised as to the scheduling of the event and possibly, there were conflicts with other activities in the community.

New Business

- 1) Parish Picture Book – The pictures for these were completed in Feb. 2009. The books are to be available before Christmas.
- 2) Capital Reserve Study – Fr. McFadden provided and update on the completed report. This report provides a look at the maintenance of Parish assets over a 20-year period. The Building and Grounds Committee will spearhead the implementation phase of the recommended projects. All the Parish councils will have the opportunity to provide input. Information will be given to the Parish as developments occur.
